A lot truly believe, that in order to succeed in the music business, one must move to one of the music capitals, such as Atlanta, Georgia, New York, New York, Los Angeles, California, just to name a few. However, this past weekend definitely proved differently, with one of the best opportunities to hit Cleveland, The New Music Seminar.

When the New Music Seminar was first mentioned, there was a lot of buzz that it was, "just another way to rip artists off". Negativity was an immense feeling about the upcoming weekend. No one believed that anything could be gained from the event. Right about now, that same group, is regretting they weren't in the building.

With the New Music Seminar, A&R representatives from record labels all over, were brought to one building, the Crowne Plaza, to give workshops, on how artists can get their music out to the public, and become "discovered". Select artists were also given a chance to perform live on stage, to be critiqued by panel, to show what they could do better, to perfect their craft.

The Crowne Plaza Hotel was filled, with artists that did believe the hype. In addition to networking, hard work is essential to survival and success in this business. Conceitedness is not a successful way to enter anything. Being confident about your craft is necessary, but one must be prepared to work long and hard to make it to the top.

So, if you missed this event, definitely beat yourself up, but redeem yourself, and don't miss the next one. Cleveland needs to be put on the map. We have talented artists here, that are as good, and even better than the bigger cities. Don't allow negativity to control your destiny!
